Gods greatest gift to us was Jesus. Jesus then gave us His whole self by his sacrifice on the cross. Through this we can have a lifetime of loving relationship with Him and eternal life. That's better than a shiny scale!! This is what we celebrate on Easter day.

Another Bible story on sharing can be found in Mark (12:41-44). Jesus is watching people come to give their offerings at the temple. He probably sees many rich people come by and put lots of money in the offering box, but it is one poor widow who catches his eye. Jesus remarks to his disciples that her offering is worth more than the bigger offerings that the rich people brought, because she has given so much out of her so little.
