Biblical link	Why it matters	Faithfulness is being confident in something or someone that is reliable, this confidence helps us to be committed to that something or someone. Our relationship with God is a perfect example of this.		
		I wonder if you believe God to be faithful? I wonder do you feel faithful to God?		
Take away response	Say: How will you respond to the message we have heard from God today?	Sometimes we can be so confident in who we put our trust in that we can take things for granted.  Be on the lookout this week for times when people are faithful to you, like when you are served your tea or when your friend is pleased to see you and thanks them. Or each morning this week when you wake up thank God for the new day and for God's faithfulness to you.
