7 Biblic link	:al	Why it matters	The fruit of the Spirit we are learning about today is Kindness. I wonder why you think kindness is important. A story in the Bible 2 Samuel 9:1-13. David and Jonathan were great friends, but Jonathan's Dad who was King Saul did not like David and many times tried to hurt him. David had to run away and hide. David and Jonathan remained friends and asked David to take care of his family. Many years later David became the King and remembered his promise to Jonathan and asked in the palace if anyone knew if there were any members of Saul or Jonathan's family left – so that he could show God's kindness to them. There was a son of Jonathan's, a man called Mephiboseth, who was poorly and could not walk. David invited Mephiboseth to live in the palace with him. He gave him and his family land to farm and he was always asked to eat at the king's table, just like David's own sons.		

8 Take away response	<b>Say:</b> How will you respond to the message we have heard from God today?	The fruits of the Spirit don't really have anything to do with a bowl of fruit. As a tree bears fruit when it is growing well, Christian's bear fruit when we are growing well as Christians - they are things that, others will see in or about us, as we get better at living how God wants us to. God wants us to show kindness to others. We probably can't all have people come and live with us and eat tea with us each day, as David did, however, we can show kindness in other ways. Can you think of some ideas? If you made the hand flower, write your ideas on the hands of the flower. Think of someone that might need kindness shown to them. How can you do this? Now go and do it.		»÷
