Biblical link	Why it matters	Ruth was not expected to stay with Naomi but Ruth did. Ruth chose to go with her mother-in-law, showing not only how dedicated she was to Naomi, but also her dedication to the God of Israel. In that instant, she decided, "Your people shall be my people, and your God my God." Ruth and Naomi had nothing, Ruth served Naomi by collecting the corn left by the harvest workers.	<b>%</b>
Take away response	Say: How will you respond to the message we have heard from God today?	To serve others means to do things for others without expecting anything in return.  Are you prepared to serve others?  Discuss ways you can do this. Then give out this Messy Church resource and encourage everyone to use it:  Messy Church Serving Take Home pdf (print p1).	
Prayer	Say: We say prayers to talk to God	Play follow the leader around the church or grounds, use prayerful actions for everyone to follow. e.g. Father God, Naomi taught Ruth about you, help us to serve those around us – <i>smile at someone</i> , Ruth worked hard to serve Naomi – <i>move to 3 places and do an action at each</i> - help us to work hard serving you – actions: <i>praying hands, flex arm muscles</i> , point to God	<b>%</b>
