Lay Training Program

Regarding the costs for the Lay training course: Tuition fee is 1,000,000TZS (£325) per year, other costs remain the same as shown in the fee structure table, except for the registration fee. Those who do Lay Training Course are not required to pay registration fee. Lay training course is only one year program.

Morogoro Bible College Scholarship Fund

Morogoro Bible College is the Anglican Training Institution for the Diocese of Morogoro, Tanzania. It is situated on a small campus in Morogoro town at the foot of the stunning Uluguru Mountains.

The College has six staff members. Three full time. Rev'd Samuel Maduma the Principal. Three other staff members are part time.

Four programmes are offered to 70 students with only two classrooms. Two are under construction but the current economic climate has halted the work.

Many students come from rural areas where they are involved in planting new churches in predominantly non-Christian areas. They are required to pay their own fees from the lands which they till. Drought (climate change) over a few years has made it increasingly difficult for students to pay sufficient for their education.

The scholarship will pay towards part of what it costs per year. Students in receipt of a scholarship will be evaluated according to need and encouraged to contribute to the scholarship fund in the future.

Registration Fee

Regarding registration, usually students who join MBC for certificate and diploma courses are required to do the Provincial entrance examination, so the prospective students are required to pay examination fee along with meals during their exam. And this exam is mandatory for all people who join the college because Morogoro Bible College uses the Provincial curriculum to prepare Church leaders; and this exam is set by the provincial theological panel.

Stationery

The cost of stationery is high because students are required to type and print most of their assignments. But they are also required to photocopy notes that teachers prepare for them for each subject. In addition, the stationery costs are for the final exams that we do the end of each semester. In addition; through stationery item we save some money for buying books especially Swahili theological books.
