Building on a solid foundation

Link exploration:

Encanto is a fun, colourful family film! The main character is Mirabel. She is part of a family who all have supernatural gifts – except her. The film explores how she finds her place in the family and how in the end everyone realises that whether they have amazing gifts and talents or not - they are all a precious part of the family.

At the end of the film the house that the family lives in is destroyed which is devastating to everyone, but then we see a community come together and rebuild the family's home. The film suggests that the house and the family's beliefs had not had the right foundation – that they needed to start again and get the important things in place.

Jesus tells a story about two people who built a house – one with sand as a foundation and one as a rock as foundation. We soon learn which house stood firm when the storm came. Now this wasn't just good advice for anyone who wants to build a new home! This is a parable (a simple story with a spiritual meaning) about our lives and helps us to explore the things important to us. Jesus says that believing in Him and following Him gives us the right foundation – the right starting point – for everything in our lives. When troubles and hard times come, our foundations in God will help us to stand strong.

Personal challenge

- Use Lego or Jenga or bricks and build a house with a firm foundation.
- Ask God to show you what He wants you to have as the foundations of your life. Write them down so you remember them, and maybe share them with a friend or someone in your family.
- Talk to an adult about their life foundations (values).
