# Link exploration:

Mr. Meacham had for years been telling stories of a dragon who lived deep in the woods. He says: 'Just because you don't see something doesn't mean it's not there.' Do we have to see something with our own eyes, for it to be real? How many things can we list that are true even though we haven't seen them ourselves? Can we know something is true because others tell us? How do we decide whose word to trust?

The Christian gospel is based on the historical event of Jesus' life, death and resurrection. Like any historical event, we can't see it with our own eyes. But we come to conclusions about this historical event from a variety of sources, including the accounts written in the Bible, which have stood the tests of historians: they were written by eye-witnesses or those who knew the eye-witnesses. They were written soon after the events. Very early fragments of the original documents are still in existence (such as the 'P52' papyrus, written around AD150 and now on display at the John Rylands Library, University of Manchester.)

### Personal challenge

- What helps you to have faith in Jesus Christ, even though you can't see Him in person?
- Think about the Bible, what do you find hard to understand or believe?
- Who could you ask, to help you with your questions?
