Link exploration:

The film 'Yes Day' sees Allison and Carlos Torres, two former free spirits, who are now parents of three children, living a life of 'No'. They have forgotten how to say 'Yes' to let more joy into their lives, to open up to different possibilities and to connect as a family. They agree to a "Yes day" in which they let their children make all the rules for 24 hours.

Throughout the film the parents had to say 'Yes' to all that the children threw their way: some of the activities were really fun and easy, other activities took them out of their comfort zone. The family spent time together and got to know each other and themselves better. Towards, the end of the film, the oldest daughter had a difficult choice to make, did she say 'Yes' to attending a concert or 'Yes' to staying and looking after her brothers and sisters? Which voice did she listen to and is it the right one?

It's the same for us. We don't have to do a lot of special things to be in God's family. All we have to do is say 'Yes' to Him and follow him.
